

SANTA BÁRBARA CASTLE

Dominating the Alicante skyline, Santa Bárbara Castle has been a symbol of the city ever since it was first built on this highly desirable site: a site which has accommodated an unending succession of settlements throughout history, its slopes studded with archaeological remains from the Bronze Age, Iberian Age and Roman times.

The castle's true value was recognised with its official declaration as a Historical-Artistic Monument and an Asset of Cultural Interest in 1961 and it quickly became a tourist attraction when it was opened to the public at the same time. At 166 metres above the city, visitors can take in the fantastic views of Alicante and its tranquil blue sea, which evoke a refreshing sense of freedom.


